

ORDER NO. 100
of the Rector of the West Pomeranian University of Technology in Szczecin
of September 12, 2022

Amending the Order No. 104 of the Rector of WPUT of 20 September 2021.
on Regulations for student residences

of the West Pomeranian University of Technology in Szczecin

Based on Article 23 in connection with Article 11, paragraph 5 of the Act of July 20, 2018 Law on Higher Education and Science (consolidated text of Journal of Laws 2022, item 574, as amended), approved by the Student Government Parliament of WPUT, it is ordered as follows:

§ 1.

The Halls of Residence Regulations of the West Pomeranian University of Technology in Szczecin, annexed to the Order No. 104 of the Rector of the West Pomeranian University of Technology in Szczecin of September 20, 2021 on the Regulations of the Halls of Residence of the West Pomeranian University of Technology in Szczecin, are amended as follows:

1) in §8, paragraph 2, after point 11, the following point 12 is added:

"12) respecting the sanitary guidelines to be introduced in the hall of residence.";

2) in § 9, paragraph 1 shall be replaced by the following:

"1. Curfew applies on the premises of the hall of residence from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.";

3) In § 11, paragraph 1a is added after paragraph 1 to read:

"1a. It is forbidden to:

1) bring single-track vehicles such as electric bicycles, scooters into the building premises;

2) charge batteries intended for vehicles (car, bicycle, scooter, etc.) from the mains and electrical installation of the West Pomeranian University of Technology in Szczecin;

3) leave objects in corridors constituting escape routes inside the building, e.g. trolleys, clothes dryers;

4) block external escape routes, in particular entrance doors, entrance gates, access roads, evacuation assembly points, etc.

4) after § 13, § 13a shall be added which reads:

"§ 13a.

(1) The manager of the hall of residence shall be entitled to impose the penalty of a warning on the occupant of the student residence in the event of a breach of the rules of order specified in Chapter IV, with the effect specified in § 17, paragraph 2a.

(2) A warning shall be imposed in writing and delivered against acknowledgement of receipt.

(3) The resident has the right to appeal against the warning imposed within 5 days of receipt. The appeal should, in particular, contain a substantive justification and shall be submitted to the Student Campus manager, whose decision is final.

(4) If an appeal is not lodged within the time limit specified in paragraph (3), the warning penalty shall become a final decision.

5) w § 17:

(a) after paragraph 2, the following paragraph 2a shall be added:

"2a. The head of the hall of residence - after imposing at least two warning penalties referred to in § 13a on a resident in the course of consecutive 6 months - may decide to deprive the resident of the right to reside, after consulting the Student Campus manager.",

(b) after paragraph 5, the following paragraph 5a shall be added:

"5a. An inhabitant evicted as a result of the reasons listed in paragraph 1, points 8 and 9 and paragraph 2, points 5 and 6 shall be prohibited from residing in the hall of residence for at least 2 calendar years.",

(c) in paragraph 7, the second sentence shall be replaced by the following: "In the event that the right to reside in the hall of residence is revoked as a result of the reasons listed in paragraph 1, points 8 and 9, and paragraph 2, points 5 and 6, within a period to be determined by the manager of the hall of residence."

§ 2.

The Order comes into effect on the date of signature.
